**MERCURY RECOVERY PROGRAM**

Mercury has been deemed a major public health concern and is an element that can be harmful to human health and the environment if not disposed of properly. The City of Methuen provides a service for residents to safely dispose of a wide variety of mercury bearing items at no cost.

**At the Methuen Board of Health,** the following mercury bearing items are collected *free* of charge:

- ▶ Thermometers
- ▶ Thermostats

Collection - Monday through Thursday, from 8:00AM -4:30PM and Friday, from 8:00AM - 12:00 Noon.

**At the Methuen Transfer Station,** the following mercury bearing items are collected *free* of charge:

- ▶ *Fluorescent Lamps (e.g. 4foot; 8 foot)*
- ▶ *Compact Fluorescents*
- ▶ *U-Tubes*
- ▶ *Circular Lamps*

**Collection: Wednesdays and Saturdays**

**NO COMMERCIAL AND NO UV LAMPS ACCEPTED AT TRANSFER STATION.**
