*The Director of the Department of Public Works is authorized, for the purpose of removing or plowing snow, or removing ice, from any way, to remove or cause to be removed, to some convenient place, including in such term a public garage, any vehicle interfering with such work and for imposing liability for the cost of such removal, and of the storage charges, if any, resulting therefrom, upon the owner of such vehicle, in accordance with provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 21, sub-section 16. Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance, unless otherwise provided by law or ordinance, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense. (Added to 1973 Ord. by Ord. #42, Jan., 1976)*

***All Night Parking Ban, Article V, Section 9***

*No person shall allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle registered in his name, other than one acting in an emergency, to be parked on any street for a period of time longer than one hour between the hours of 1:00 am and 6:00 am of any day from December 1 of one year to April 1 of the next year.*
