What do I need to know about Medicare Open Enrollment?

Medicare Open Enrollment: October 15 – December 7.

SHINE counselors can help you with all things Medicare

Your health insurance costs are an important part of your budget and Medicare Open Enrollment is your opportunity to review your Medicare plans with a SHINE counselor to see what you can expect with your current plan in 2025, or to learn about all options that may be most cost-effective for you. You may also benefit from cost-savings programs which a SHINE counselor will explain to you. Medicare plans can change annually, and changes are expected for 2025.

This can affect your health care and drug costs. SHINE = Serving the Health Insurance Needs of Everyone...on or eligible for Medicare.

Certified SHINE counselors are available all year, and offer free, unbiased confidential counseling on all aspects of Medicare health insurance.
