Merrimack Valley Transit Proudly Provides MiniMeVa Free Services Non- ADA (over the age of 60)

Our **MiniMeVa** Non-ADA service is offered to people who are 60 years of age or older who live in communities that receive MeVa's fixed bus route service. MeVa's fixed bus route service operates in Amesbury, Andover, Groveland, Haverhill, Lawrence, Merrimac, Methuen, Newburyport, North Andover and Salisbury. Residents must complete an application through the **MiniMeVa** administrative office. Applications are available online at www.mevatransit.com, at our offices at 85 Railroad Ave, Haverhill or by mail by calling 978-469-6878 (option 3).

This service complements Merrimack Valley Transit's (MeVa) fixed bus route service and is an origin to destination shared ride service. (Door to door upon request.)

Service is provided with **MiniMeVa** lift-equipped vehicles and on occasion is supplemented with other vehicles that may be vans or sedans. This service is intended to safely and efficiently accommodate as many customers per trip as possible.

SHINE NEWS

You may have a Special Enrollment Period (SEP) to make changes to your Medicare plan for a limited time. Most SEPs are limited to specific situations. If you are currently enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, HMO-POS, PPO) you can change to Original Medicare with a Medigap and a Drug Plan or change to a different Medicare Advantage Plan through the end of March. Also, if your 2024 plan is no longer available in 2025, or if you are eligible for a Medicare Savings Program, you may have a SEP to make a change. Timelines vary for these SEPs so be sure to reach out to SHINE to learn of your options. A SHINE counselor will review your coverage and will help determine if you are qualified to make a change at this time of year.

Certified SHINE counselors offer free, unbiased, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on or eligible for Medicare. SHINE counselors will also assist to help you understand Medicare and your options.

Our SHINE counselor will be available for Virtual Appointments on Mondays starting January 1st. Appointments are limited - please call to schedule your appointment today at 978-983-8825.


